PREFACE

Faith for Difficult Times (II) is coming to you with the theme - Activating God's Mercy in Difficult Times. God's mercy is available to you when faith seems difficult to exercise. God's mercies are sure for you, if you will just appropriate and activate it especially where cause of present difficulty is traceable to a mistake you made (your fault) or the fault of someone else.

We all sometimes fall short of expectation, and deserve to be reprimanded. Guilt often makes it difficult to exercise faith or boldness in asking God for help. Just imagine how hard it could be for a felon to ask God for mercy, to spare his or her life after death sentence has been pronounced but as difficult as this may be, God's

mercy is still available. So, it is up to you.

God's mercy, the extension of His patience (compassion, consideration, salvation, shalom, pity, undeserved favour and help) is not given because we deserve it. If you see it this way, you may come up with the wrong conception- that God owes you mercy. BUT mercy cannot be owed, it's just an extension of God's kindness and grace to those who do not deserve it. It will be nice we have a bit of educating on mercy. However, settle it within your heart, that God's mercy towards you are new every morning.

Mercy in Hebrew is Racham, Kapporeth, or Chesed:

- *Racham means “to love or have compassion,” to have a disposition of mercy; Kapporeth means “ransom” and it’s associated with the “mercy seat” in Scripture; and Chesed means “goodness,” “kindness,” or “mercifulness.”*

Mercy in Greek is Eleemon or Oiktirmos:

- *Eleemon, meaning “to have pity on,” to “show compassion,” or to “be merciful”; and Oiktirmos also suggests compassion or pity. It’s the idea of divine forbearance in showing compassion and passing over sins.*

Oxford Dictionaries asserts that,

- ◆ *Mercy is compassion or forgiveness shown towards*

*someone whom it is within one's power to punish or harm. Additionally, it presented **mercy as a thing, incident or happening to be grateful for, because it prevents something unpleasant or provides relief from suffering.***

Dictionary.com states that,

- ◆ ***Mercy is the discretionary power of a judge (in this case God, the supreme judge and jury in one) to pardon someone or to alleviate punishment.***

One of our main actors in this edition of faith for difficult times, Jonah, enjoyed the kind of mercy thus described. His was a story of the wisdom and benefit of having faith in God's mercy. God

challenged Jonah to activate His mercy instead of burying his life in the wrong place or while going the wrong direction. He was running away from God in refusing to take up his purpose and assignment.

Yes, trying time embraced with the right attitude; will land you on the side of celebration. There are things you will not know about, that might not emerge from inside you, until you go through a season or some seasons (if you are not a very fast learner). So, a great way to exercise faith in these trying times is to, believe there is a learning

curve in it for you, somewhere,
somehow.

Learning on Joseph's example,
man has to be delivered from
pleasure to be landed in purpose.
And do you know the real lasting
pleasures are in accomplishing
your purpose? Oh, the fulfilment,
satisfaction! If Joseph was left in
the pleasure of being his father's
favourite, to continue basking in
the euphoria of the one fit and
chosen for the coat of many
colours, he may not have
amounted to much. Ever heard this
line "who the cap fit, let them wear
it" from Bob Marley's track – man
to man is so unjust?

Steamed To Thrive

The challenge of an early crown-
the cage that those who were

always tops in the young days are trapped in. The sudden, I'm entitled to success feeling in the early adulthood that depletes them of the steam to thrive in life. But the real caps, are for those doggedly determined to cancel the lies that they were not bright enough, not disciplined enough, not serious enough. The not so goods in their early stages have a point or many points to prove.

They are out to force the naysayers to swallow their shitty words; and make sure they swallow it down the bottom of their stomach. They grovel from the very bottom of life, fighting their way to their very top. You need steam to thrive, and you find such steam during trying time. Painful reality is, only those with solid faith and the right attitude

gain the advantage of challenges. Yes, only those looking for opportunities to use the covid-19 challenge to become millionaire.

All you might just need to do in this season is to sit down with yourself, and review your journey so far; locate your lapse, see areas you need growing in, others you need to improve and overall discovery of a better way to do whatever you are doing right now. This is the season to seed or plant for some great harvest. This is the season to do some strategic investing; and if you have the guts to doing some heavy risking go ahead.

There Is More to Challenges

Just look around, there is more than death in covid-19. Shine your

eyes. Every wind that blows carries with itself and everything on its path – sort of taking along with it the good, the bad, and the ugly. But what you pick up from the wind depends on what you were or are looking for. Millionaire status, bankruptcy, divorce, strengthened marriages, wisdom, foolishness, death, life, industries, companies, etc., came with covid-19 just as they came with recessions and depressions of the past. I almost forgot; depression and repression (emotional, financial, economical, political, societal, national and global) also came with covid-19.

As for Joseph, providence, cut short the euphoria and released him to face the Pit, Potiphar and Prison; just as covid-19 is to some

of you out there. But you have to see it.

Again, I advice you against being overambitious; and that you do more soul searching than anything else you plan on doing or are doing right now. And please, put some faith to whatever you are doing. Additionally, I'll advice you to stay safe; in all that you do, it will be to your benefit to abide by all the known covid-19 prevention measure. Rest assured, the physical cure is with us, waiting for the container to see it.

It Is For Your Own Good.

For his own good, Joseph was rudely; harshly pulled from the grip of the pleasure of his father's love. He first went down below the plain of normal human

participation, he found himself in a pit; the people into whose arms and world he was born into – his family, people of his own house; his background and upbringing. He left the pit for slave labour in Potiphar firm, where he got his first opportunity to train for his supervisory, leadership and productivity skill. It took slavery to expose his leadership, administrative skills. Right there his integrity was tested, and he passed. Who knows what school the covid-19 has enrolled you in; and what you are learning right now.

This is purposeful, the first time he was outside his father's constant attention and love. He must have built his life around his father's greatness, and must have harboured the opinion that his

father would give him a smooth take off. He shared his dream with them, probably thinking they were going to help. The Creator more often than not, arranges situations and circumstances to separate people for their purpose. He does this to detach them from the familiar. Your purpose is an uncharted territory yet. So, that attachment to the familiar could be an hindrance; that is why life creates seasons, times or moments of separation.

Reassess/Review Your Journey.

In the pit Joseph might have wondered how he was going to make it without his dad; he may have wished that his brothers were going to change their mind. At a point, it might have seemed to

him, a huge joke. This could be what covid-19 represents to some of you out there, yes, you reading these lines. He was facing the big test of his life. He was dragged into the reality of life outside the cover of his father; and the possibility of still making it without his father.

In the pit he was alone for the first time – outside the love of his father. Can I make it alone, how do I get out of this pit? Providence intervened and he found himself on the surface and on his way to the place of purpose, with the wrong title. And many of us ended inside the wrong title, we failed to hold on to the possibility of our dreams coming to pass. See the gap between the titles - slave and prime minister. Don't give up. To give up is to kill your dream. You might be wearing the wrong title

or identity right now; still, don't give up. Attitude is everything. Attitude is altitude

A great attitude is how to retain your conviction, no matter the hard times you must face to reach there. Everyone is sure of himself or herself, until a test shows up. Tests come to check the depth of your convictions and commitment to your dreams and destiny.

Joseph's mind was made up to go all the way; he was not going to compromise his dream, destiny or purpose for a one-night stand. He had a great attitude, the way he kept contributing excellence at all times, with any badge he had on at the time.

With his great attitude, there was never a dull moment. And he was promoted from governing a

household, a one-man business – Potiphar’s firm, to head a state institution. He had to move over to the prison, to learn state affairs; he was getting closer to the manifestation of his destiny. He interacted with state officers, had some discussion and got insight into such level of governance. He developed solid rapport with the ministers of wine and pastries; to the extent they discussed with him their personal fears about regaining their offices.

There’s Change in Your Challenge.

The angle from which I’m approaching the difficulties of Joseph on his way to fulfilment of purpose, made the whole ordeal he went through to seem little. Yes, it will be the same for you if you

can find a connection between you and previous or present difficulty. All you need to look for in difficult times is that connection. Suffering, difficulties and hard-times are wasted if we cannot link them with our purpose. Anyhow, there is always something to learn from a difficult situation.

The gist is; being a person of purpose, you have faith to move to the other side of difficulties; i.e. the promotion it is preparing you for. See difficulties as preparations for excellence, eminence and greatness. Difficulties hinder or cause us to have to face challenges; it is being conditioned by physical/emotional separation, social stigma and economic hard times. As seen from the case of Joseph, our difficulties could be the individuals we relate with, who do

not understand us, and
rate/conclude on us from their
skewed judgment of us.

Such individuals in workplace
settings especially if they are your
supervisor, could conditions your
growth in the organization, for
career ladder jobs. That a very
difficult situation right there; and
the way organizations functions,
even if a new person takes over,
they often carry on with the status
quo. This is really hard, but could
be an opportunity for you to check
yourself, what the real issues are.
You may want to know if you are
in the wrong industry for your
make up. You also want to find out
if there are aspects of your life you
should be more alive to. And so on.

Once you've deduced that your
assignment in life, is from God, you

should be at home with the reality that it is going to be hard to accomplish; I didn't say it will be impossible. The first difficulty to overcome is bringing yourself to agree that executing your assignment is partnering with God, and you must acknowledge him the way you go about it.

Sometimes, you are handed a difficult task or project to handle at school or work. Difficulties are always hard to deal with, or understand. But they are points of self-release and self-application.

Do you know the fun thing about difficult and hard times? They are blessings in disguise. Difficulties can be fun. How? When you embrace them with faith and focus on the good, they came with. With a great attitude of faith, you can see some virtue in difficult times.

Despite knowing how uncomfortable and unbearable they can be, they can be fun if you see them as mere challenges of life.

Perception to Perfection

Perception! That's what life is all about; your perception, how you see things and what you name the situation. Faith gives one an edge and a possibility angle to see everything from; just like picking out the light in darkness, grace in every disgrace, sense in every nonsense, honour in every dishonour.

My faith education and training under the likes of Benson Idahosa, Napoleon Hill, Norman Vincent Peale, John Mason, Ayo Oritsejafor, Oral Roberts, Kenneth Copeland,

and a host of others, enabled me to know and apply faith variedly as it fits into the situation on ground. They and my study of bible heroes made me know that there are different kinds of faith and different ways to apply them. So, the kind of faith you'll apply depends on the nature of the difficult time. Not to worry, there is a common master faith that works for all situations: Your trust in God that He is ever available and able to handle your case; He is master at making a way where there seem to be no way.

Every man born of a woman is born to take advantage of troubles, challenges and difficulties.

I had this particular hard time that so stunned me, I didn't know what to do; I couldn't pray, didn't know

how to go about it. It was my share of difficult times. And it's not always fair, no matter the size and shape in which they come. But I somehow, came out on top of the situation with victory. It took a great attitude of calm reliance in God and faith action as a result. It was a caesarean section operation that stood my wife and baby between life and death; but I knew that God is able, available, willing to do good things. Which in this case, meant safe operation, with mother and baby alive.

Victory all the way!

The night before, from around 9pm my pregnant wife began to be in serious pain, she was still a month and a week from her DD.

We held on till the dawn of a the next day, 5am, the morning, the morning of a new day; and I took her to the clinic, a distance of 45 minutes from our house. As we drove to the clinic, I did what is usually the case with me in tensed up situation; I called families, friends and co-pastors to support us with their prayers. It was an emergency when we got to the clinic, and in six hours over nine pints of blood has been pumped into her, in preparation for the caseran operation; then I had to leave her there to go to work the same day.

After about one hour when I got to work, the clinic called, asking me to endorse them the permission to go ahead with the operation. Of course I did, it was the only one way out, reading from the

situation; she had to go through with it. The situation has degenerate to the extent that the child had to be removed safely; the medical specialists felt it was safer to take care of both of them separately. Thus far, all I did was ask God, how He expected me to pray, as I had not faced anything of such before. Those times when I don't know what to pray, I'll just get very calm inside, opening up to get a whisper from God, on the next step to take.

So, I leaned back on the Spirit (Infinite Intelligence), who prod me to log on to the internet and type on google – Lying Vanities. I'd learned overtime to align with God before asking Him to do anything for me; at least He gets to answer a prayer He put in my heart in the first place. So, I got really quiet

inside. Guess what! It was in that quite moment, I heard clearly, “log into your computer and look up the phrase ‘Lying Vanities.’” This was me, with my wife 15 minutes away from entering into the theater for an operation that was a 50/50 affair; and the LORD leading me to check this phrase out. So, I logged into my computers, and typed into google search “Lying Vanities.”

Guess what I found, a Bible verse, Jonah 2:8 and commentary on it in bible hub: They that observe (regard) lying vanities forsake their own mercy. A summary of the commentaries stipulates that those who regard lying vanities depend on things except God; they refuse their own felicity and that goodness which they would otherwise receive from God.

From my very short research it occurred to me that “Lying Vanities” are things as they appear; the nastiness, unredeemableness or irreversibility of a bad situation. Especially when everything is shouting, there is no way out; you have lost this fight (game, match, bid, contract) and you are going down. Which in my case, believing that good will come out of the situation from the way things were, was difficult to release; conditions were messy, unless God’s mercy plays its part. God is saying, I’m with you in this valley of the shadow of death; but here we are in the very valley of death. So, where is your faith? In the recesses of my heart, it was settled that God could do this, but the

condition was screaming how do you trust God to save.

The situational report was totally inconsistent with God's ability to redeem the situation. The Word of God about my situation: "Is there anything too hard for God to do?" No! A zillion times No. That my wife had 50/50 chance was a lying vanity, as it ran contrary to God's word. With this calm assurance, was a sudden surge of faith within me, I didn't have to pray again. I stepped right on top of the situation; and almost asked people to stop praying about it.

God's Mercies Overrides Lying Vanities

The sudden incursion of the corona virus caused a global panic;

indifference, suspicion, fear, propaganda, lies, etc., was flying everywhere. The panic and fear was due largely to the way the media was reporting the situation; the number of deaths everyday across the globe was on the rise. Those who maintained their poise were able to reason:

- ◆ Are more people dying now than before on daily basis?
- ◆ It is possible that some (if not most of the death) attributed to the virus, may be due to other diseases or sicknesses with related symptoms.
- ◆ No matter how long we stay here, we get to die some day; and people die everyday in the world from other disease, we are yet to get cure for.

- ◆ Why all the panic, after all we brought the situation upon us?
- ◆ Is God trying to tell us something, like we need to be careful before we destroy ourselves?
- ◆ Is covid-19 going to close the age?
- ◆ What should we do now? In answer to this question,
 - √ Some went to the laboratory to research the situation
 - √ Some began looking into reports of related previous researches on chemical/biological warfare; and were coming out with findings
 - √ Sound clergies began clarifying misconception

on teachings about the last days

- √ Some went to the frontlines to give help, medical personnel put their lives on the line
- √ Government started implementing control up to declaring economic, political, social, border lockdowns
- √ Some used the situation to build on their social media presence
- √ Senior pastors and televangelist across the globe called for international and national days of prayers on social media

Some situations come into your life that makes praying difficult;

the panic stage of covid-19 was such a time. But after two months or so, nations, institutions and individuals are finding a way around it.

From my experience of God's intervention in the victorious delivery of my son – mother and baby alive and strong; I began looking for God in the covid-19 scourge. Listening for what He has to say (stayed away from the social media) and comparing the situation to my knowledge about the last days.

Have you ever been in a situation in which it was hard to pray (for those who do) or come up with a workable direction out of the problem? Have you ever found yourself in a confusing, frustrating, no-wind situation; situated

between the devil and the deep blue sea? Harsh experience, I agree. I heard that at such times, you should calm down, maintain poise, clear your mind, come out of the panic, face the reality, weigh the situation and decide to see victory at the end of you. You should begin looking for little wins here and there. To those who believe in praying to God, it is at such times that you should pray most, especially when you cannot articulate the challenge (when there is no feeling to pray).

Conclusion

Rounding of in the words of Pastor Chris Oyakhilome:

- A lying vanity is anything that isn't consistent with the Word of God for you as a new creation in Christ Jesus. Refuse to observe lying vanities. Those who observe lying vanities forsake their mercies; they frustrate the grace of God, thereby short-circuiting the power of God from working in their behalf.

They that regard lying vanities forsake their own mercy. Jonah, the original recipient of this challenge was running away from God, and was being drowned by his disobedience; when God

extended him mercy in this words, “as it appears right now, you are done for, and going down with the situation; but Mercy is available to you, reach out and grab it.” All Jonah did was acknowledge that even in his sinful, disobedient state, all he needed to do was turn to God, and away from his inability to handle the situation he landed himself into.

Some school of thought are of the opinion that since you brought the situation on yourself, keep God out of it; some individuals feel they must suffer the consequence of their sin. Jonah thought so too, when he said throw me into the open, this situation is my fault; let me suffer the consequence alone. But then God interrupt the situation saying to Jonah, who told you such a lie; see My mercies

(they are renewed daily, you have a daily dose of mercy), grab it.

Jonah suddenly awakened to the covenant of the sure mercies of David, made this declaration: “I called God, He heard my voice, He answered me, and He’s brought me out of the pit this situation threw me into. At Your prodding, I remembered (was reminded and recalled) your mercies (and gave up lying vanities); my prayers and petition for Your mercy caused You to lift me above the situation into safety.”

That your soul fainted within you, might be a fact, but it is a lying vanity; and God’s mercies is available to override your situation, and land you in victory. Lying vanities always stand powerless against God’s mercy.

Affirmations:

- I am apportioned sure mercies from God (and it is renewed daily); making available to me a daily dose of mercies.
- I refuse to forsake my own apportioned God's sure mercies.
- In thanking God for a way in His mercies, I am thanking my way out of my present predicament and down day.
